Try this incredible sake for yourself, as well as sake from Yamaguchi Prefecture that has a rich, but light flavor profile differing from the sake of Saijō. From sake to local Miyoshi wines, to single malt Japanese whisky Togouchi, savor the drinks featured during the G7 Hiroshima Summit 2023 along with elegant meals that complement them.

Hiroshima Peace Tour by Chartered Tram and Bike Excursion

ABOUT THIS EXPERIENCE

Retrace the history of Hiroshima from the catastrophic damage of the atomic bombing to its incredible recovery. The streetcars that survived the bombing and continue to run today are known as hibaku streetcars. They began running just three days after the bombing and are a symbol of Hiroshima's recovery. Take a ride in one of these historic cars and learn about the history of Hiroshima and peace from an interpreter who will guide you through the city. See what Hiroshima was like before the bombing with virtual reality tour technology in Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park, before taking a guided bicycle tour which highlights the city's recovery. In the evening, enjoy the guiet beauty of the city.

Japanese Swords and the Chūgoku Region

ABOUT THIS EXPERIENCE

Experience the world of Japanese swords, a symbol of samurai culture. Admire the Japanese swords on display at the Bizen Osafune Sword Museum located in Setouchi City, Okayama, a city known for making Japanese swords in the Bizen osafune style. Afterwards, you'll learn how these incredible swords are made, as well as tour a tatara ironmaking facility, which produces the iron used in making swords and ironware, and even get some hands-on experience! We end the tour at Ōyamazumi Shrine on Ōmishima, home to 80% of the weapons and armor designated as National Treasures and National Important Cultural Properties, including swords from the Middle Ages, armor, and more.

ABOUT THIS EXPERIENCE

Experience the extraordinary in the San'in region, home to places you won't find anywhere else, including the most hazardous National Treasure in Japan, as well as the biggest sand dunes in all of the country. Nageire-dō Hall in Sanbutsu-ji Temple on Mt. Mitoku is known as the most hazardous National Treasure in Japan due to the challenging hiking trail to get there. Perched cliffside, the hall is surrounded by natural beauty and is an architectural marvel. At the Tottori Sand Dunes, the biggest in the country, you can try your hand at beginners paragliding across the expansive dunes or zip around on a Segway.

The Seto Inland Sea is full of incomparable beauty, dotted with about 700 islands, and known for its mild climate. Colorful and unique bridges span between islands and the ever-changing contrast of islands, ocean, and sky will have you captivated. Experience the grandeur of the Seto Inland Sea and its many islands through visits to places like Shimokamagarijima Island, where boats would dock in the Edo period and diplomatic missions of old would visit, as well as the Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter, Okayama Castle, and Korakuen Garden. Each new island provides you the chance to get a glimpse of island culture and connect with locals.



Savor the unique food cultures of Okayama and Hiroshima on this gourmet tour! Thanks to abundant sunshine and advanced technological developments, Okayama is home to many farms where you can hand-pick seasonal, premium fruit. In addition to fruit, try Okayama's famed Japanese confection, kibi dango. In Hiroshima, the gourmet tour begins with breakfast made using local ingredients and served on Mt. Futaba with a view of the whole city. For lunch, savor Hiroshima soul food Okonomiyaki. Don't forget a snack: Hiroshima- favorite momiji manjū (small, maple leaf-shaped cakes)!

Careful manufacturing that Japan is known for and cutting edge, eco-friendly manufacturing that uses the latest technology come together in the Chūgoku region. Kojima Jeans in Okayama was the first company to make domestic-made jeans. Popular overseas, jeans may have been invented in the US, but they have evolved in Japan, where each hand-sewn pair is made with care. On the manufacturing side, known for their beautiful design and beloved the world over, you'll take a tour of the Mazda car factory and of storage battery production plant Power Base, an eco-friendly, state-of-the-art facility designed by world-famous architect, Kazuyo Sejima.

Natural Wonders and Culture of San'in Geopark and National Park

ABOUT THIS EXPERIENCE

The geological features and landscape in San'in Geopark have remained unchanged from the time that the Japanese archipelago was a part of the Asian continent. Experience local culture and history rooted in the colorful, natural landscape of the park. Enjoy outdoor activities on the Tottori Sand Dunes and Mt. Daisen, and, on Oki-no-Shima Island, once a part of the Eurasian continent,

you'll find Matengai Cliff rising 257 meters straight up from the surface of the sea off the Kuniga Coast. Cows and horses graze atop the cliff, providing a surreal pastoral view that contrasts with the sea below. Arched stone bridge Tsūten-kyō is another highlight of the park.



Resilience Against the Power of Nature, Past to Present

ABOUT THIS EXPERIENCE

Since ancient times, the Chūgoku region has been home to a variety of places steeped in the knowledge of disaster mitigation. On this tour, you'll visit infrastructure such as the Kintaikyō Bridge in Yamaguchi Prefecture. The bridge's highly unique five connecting arches are the result of the passion of our forebearers who wanted to build a bridge that would not be washed away. You'll also visit Tomata Dam in Okayama, built in the modern era. Able to handle flooding due to typhoons and dry years due to decreased rainfall, the dam plays an active part in managing water to control flooding and water utilization. In addition, you'll also tour storage battery production plant Power Base, an eco-friendly, state-of-the-art facility designed by world-famous architect, Kazuyo Sejima.





ABOUT THIS EXPERIENCE

The Chūgoku region has long been a hub for trade and manufacturing, and each community within the region has a one-of-a-kind townscape that reflects their individual history. The Shirakabe Dozōgun storehouses of Kurayoshi are modeled off castle towns in the Muromachi period. In the Edo period, commerce and industry flourished and you can still see traces of that in the

town today. The Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter once prospered as a hub for trade via ships. The traditional and cohesive townscape is balanced by the beautiful weeping willow-lined streets. Takahashi City, famed for its production of red ocher and copper, is the birthplace of the color known as Japan Red, and its distinctive red townscape continues to welcome visitors today.

On this tour, you'll also discover Nageire-dō Hall, known as the most hazardous National Treasure in Japan. Considered sacred, it is used as the final destination for Shugendō training in the tradition of Japanese

mountain asceticism that worships the gods of the mountain and whose monks train in rugged mountain areas. The region is full of castles that use the natural environment around them to their advantage, as well as the castle towns that thrived around them. Come and experience the natural beauty of the region, as well as the cities, towns, and livelihoods born from it.



World Heritage and Myths of Japan Tour

ABOUT THIS EXPERIENCE

Visit three different world heritage sites in the Chūgoku region from three eras: the Itsukushima Shrine, Iwami Silver Mine, and the Atomic Bomb Dome. The floating vermillion torii gate of the Itsukushima Shrine on Miyajima is a sight that symbolizes Japan. In its heyday, Japanese silver comprised one-third of the world's silver, and of that Japanese silver, most of it came from the Iwami Silver Mine. The mine was profitable enough to cover the expenses of sengu (building a new home for a deity) for the

Itsukushima Shrine when the main hall was rebuilt. The Atomic Bomb Dome continues to convey to the world the horrors of the atomic bombing and appeal for lasting world peace. Learn the history and historical context of these three sights, as well as the reason why they continue to be preserved for the next generation.

Then, in Bizen City, admire Bizen-yaki pottery, an extremely simple form of pottery that makes use of the natural colors of the clay and doesn't rely on decorations. Be sure to purchase your favorite piece as a souvenir from your trip!






Discover the Magic of Kagura in the Chūgoku Region

The Chūgoku region is home to one of the most active kagura communities in Japan. Kagura began as an ancient ritual to pray for a bountiful harvest and plentiful catch of fish, as well as to ward off illness, and it has been performed across Japan since days of old. The dynamic movements, extravagant costumes, pounding taiko drums, and lilting kagura flute differ in each community. This tour will introduce you to three styles of kagura that continue to be passed down in their respective communities today: Bitchu Kagura emphasizes the entertainment elements, whereas Akitakata Kagura focuses more on the dramatic elements and has a wide appeal. Iwami Kagura features clear-cut stories that are easy for beginners to follow.


