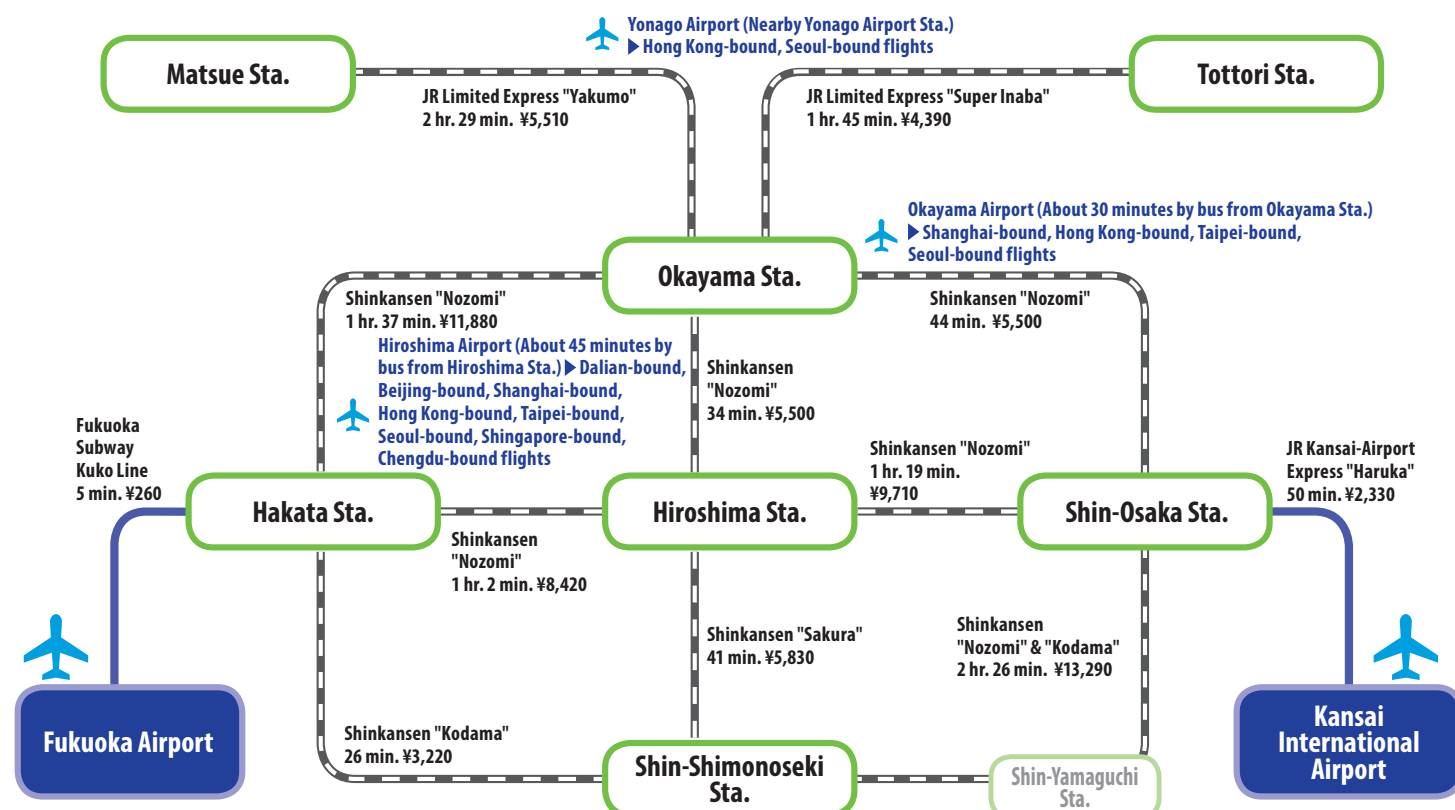

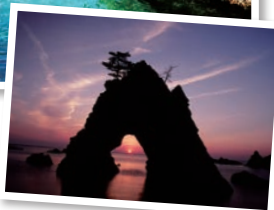


## 3 Uradome Coast

## 4 Mitokusan Sanbutsuji Temple

### 三徳山 三佛寺

This is an old temple of the Tendai sect of Buddhism. The "Nageiredo" is built on a precipitous cliff and is designated as a national treasure. Even today method of its construction remains a mystery. Also the approach to "Nageiredo" hall is a steep pilgrimage path. There are strict rules enforced regarding clothing and shoes for entry to the mountain so be sure to note them.

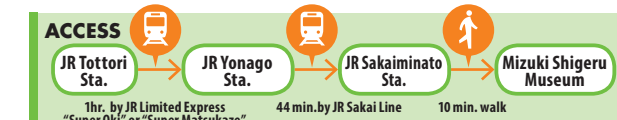


## 7 Mizuki Shigeru Museum

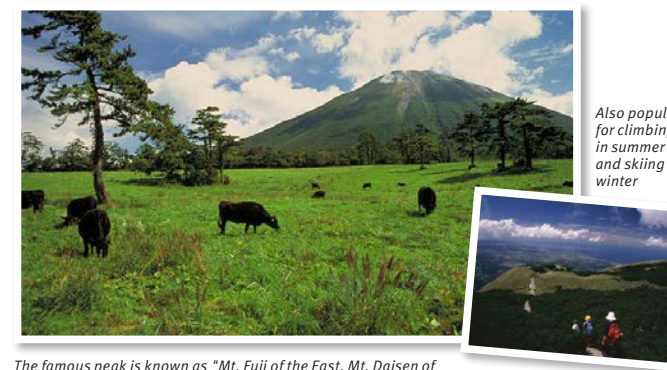
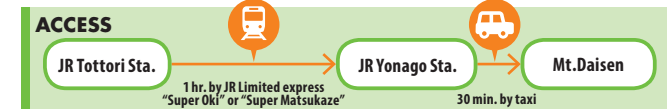

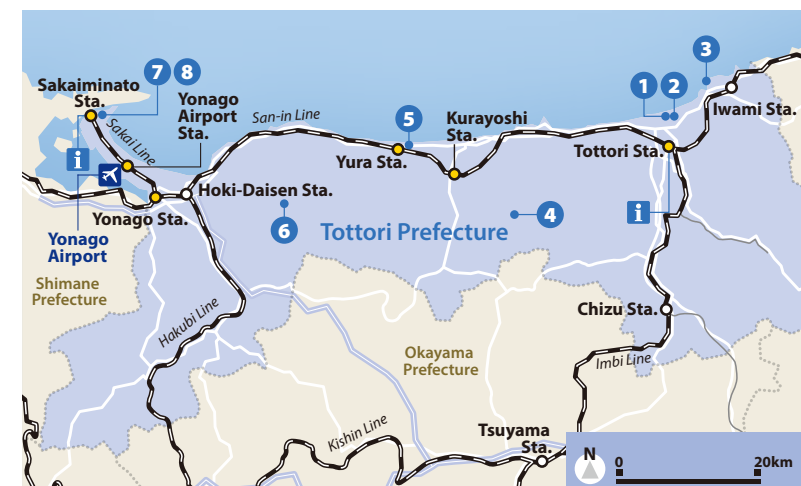


## 8 Sakaiminato Sea Food Market

出雲大社

Okuninushi-no-omikami, the main enshrined deity, is worshipped here as the god of matchmaking. It is said that in the 10th month of lunar calendar all the gods in Japan gather at Izumo Taisha Grand Shrine. When you pray at the shrine, bow twice, clap 4 times, and bow once with a heartfelt respect to the God.

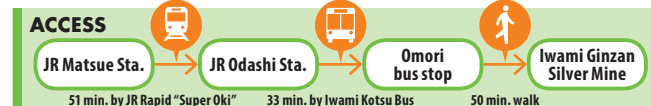

## 2 Iwami Ginzan Silver Mine & Omori Town

石見銀山・大森の街並み

Japan's largest silver mine where silver was mined in the early Edo period (ca. 1600-1700). It was registered as a World Heritage Site in 2007. Visit the Ryugenji Mabu mine shaft remains or stroll along the streets of Omori which retains the remnants of old times.

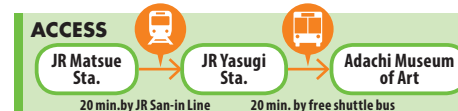

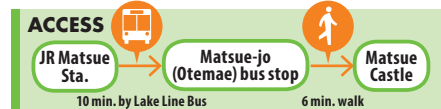

松江城

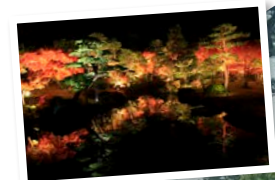

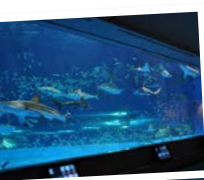


## 3 Shimane AQUAS Aquarium

島根県立しまね海洋館アクアス

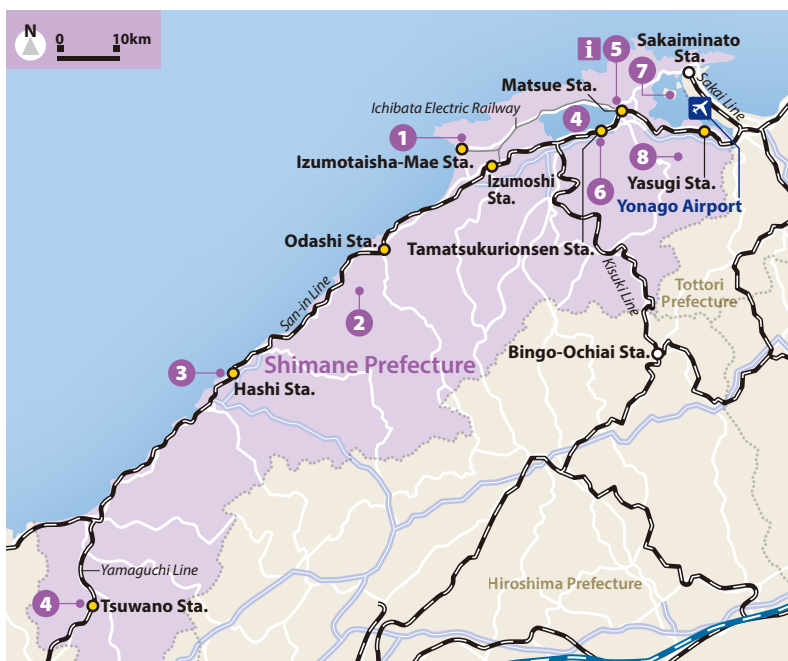

## 1 Okayama Korakuen Garden & Okayama Castle

### 岡山後楽園・岡山城

Japanese garden built by Ikeda Tsunamasa, lord of Okayama, over 300 years ago. Later on, subsequent feudal lords added their tastes to the garden in successive periods and the Korakuen has become one of the Three Great Gardens of Japan, a beautiful place both to admire and to stroll around.

## 3 Mt. Washuzan & Kojima

## 4 Kibitsujinja Shrine

### 吉備津神社

This is one of the oldest shrines in the San-yo area. Okibitsuhiko-no-omikami is enshrined in the main hall which is the sole example of the *kibitsu-zukuri* style of architecture in Japan. The legend of Kibitsuhiko defeating an ogre is believed to be the origin of the famous folktale Momotaro which is handed down in Okayama.

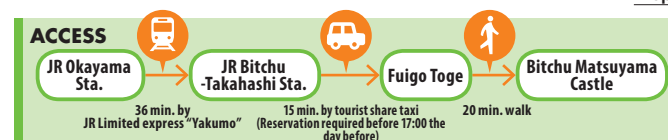

## 5 Bitchu Matsuyama Castle

### 備中松山城

One of 12 original surviving castles in Japan that have castle keeps. As the only original hilltop castle that retains its castle keep, it is also an Important Cultural Property. Standing on a 430 m-high hilltop, the castle is famed as an impregnable fortress.

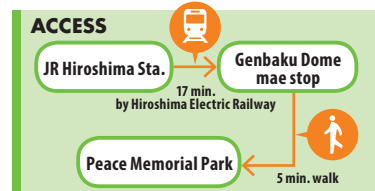

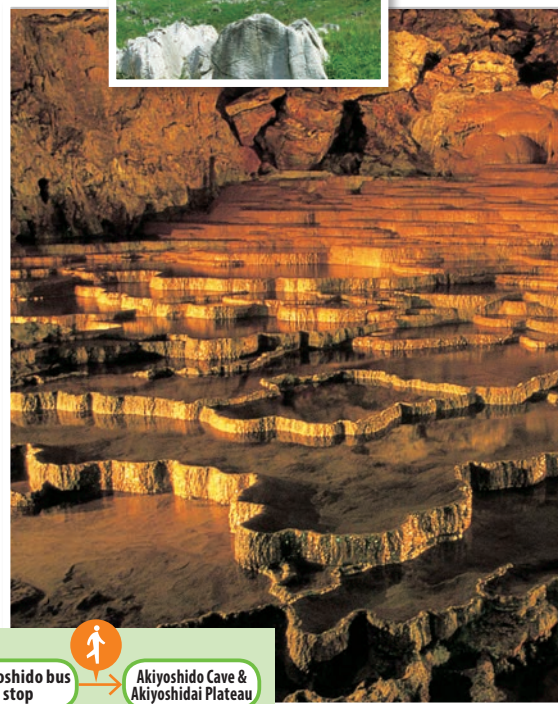

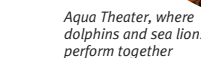
